A message from our Board Chair Diane Goss

Over the past year, Canine Partners of the Rockies has experienced remarkable growth and meaningful accomplishment. As Board Chair, I am proud to reflect on a year defined not only by increased impact, but by the deepening of our commitment to the individuals and communities we serve.

In 2025, we exceeded expectations by increasing our placement numbers by 25%, a milestone that represents more than a statistic, it reflects greater independence, confidence, and connection for our clients across Colorado.

We also successfully renewed our accreditation through Assistance Dogs International, affirming that our programs continue to meet the highest internationally recognized standards for the training, placement, and lifelong support of service dogs. This distinction underscores the integrity and excellence at the heart of our work.

None of this progress would be possible without the dedication of our volunteer community. In 2025, more than 125 volunteers generously gave their time and talents in support of our mission. This represents over a 24% increase in volunteer hours from last year that has strengthened our capacity to serve. Their commitment enables us to expand placements and reach more individuals whose lives are transformed through the human canine interaction.

As we look ahead, we remain inspired by what is possible and grounded in the knowledge that every partnership we create changes a life, not only for our clients, but for families and communities throughout Colorado.

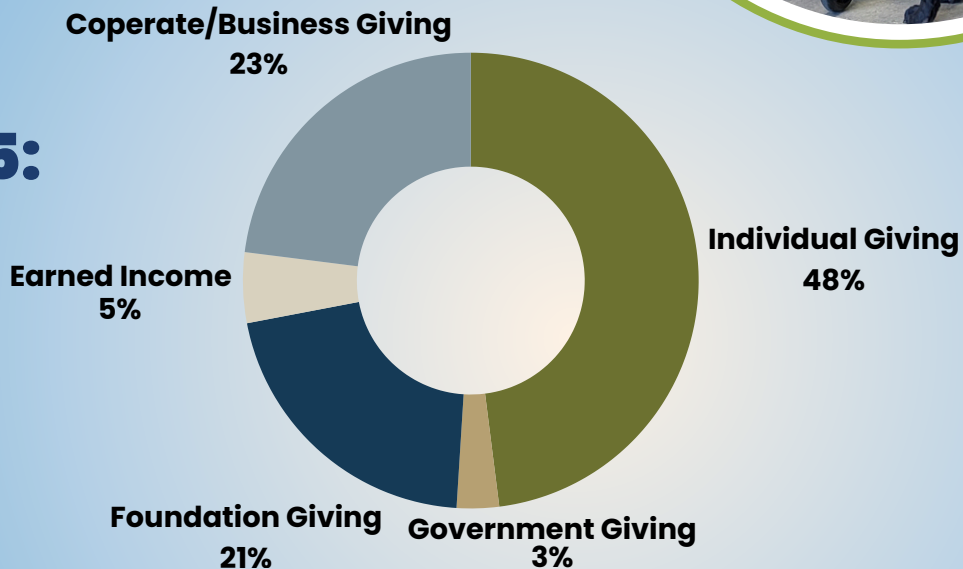

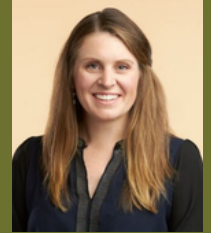
Bowties and Tails

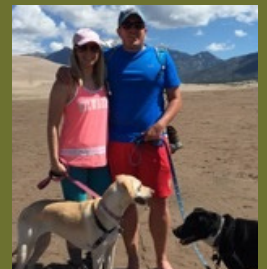

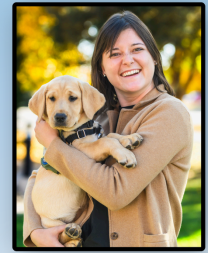
